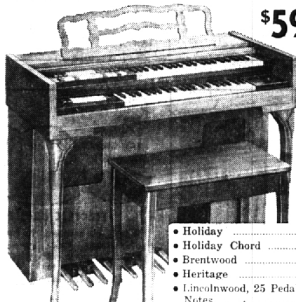

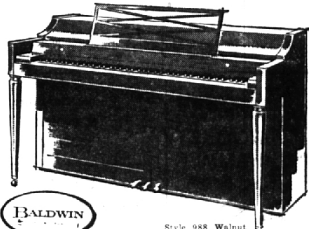

Judge Advises Compromise On Zone Suit

BLOOMFIELD TOWNSHIP—An out-of-court settlement may be made by Bloomfield Township in a zoning case involving property at the southeast corner of Lahser and Maple.
Township board members Monday night authorized attorney Tom Dillon to proceed with negotiations for a compromise settlement in the case.

THE MOVE came after Dillon reported to the board on a pre-trial hearing of the case before Circuit Court Judge Beers. Beers suggested an attempt at settlement by the township and owners of the property, Schmier-Schmier and Katzman.
The suit arose after the township rezoned the property from residential to multiple dwelling last year. Owners of the property are seeking to have the property zoned commercial.

THE PROPERTY lies adjacent to residential property in Westchester Village. It is across Maple from a commercial development including a service station and a super market.
The property in question was designated residential until its recent rezoning, while the property across Maple was reserved for commercial at the time of its platting in the 1920's.
