## Poorly-Insulated Walls Are Cause Of Chilling Drafts

Most people think of a draft as chilling air that breezes in through an open door or window. That's not necessarily so.

Much more common in winter are second drafts that originate inside a closed-up house. Caused by cold, poorly-insulated walls, these drafts can't be shut off as easily as the door and window variety, and can be extremely uncomfortable.

Even more important, especially to parents of young children who like to play on the floor—is the health hazard.

Drafts of this kind are created when heated air inside a house rises to the ceiling and moves to a cold wall. The air cools rapidly when it touches the wall, and drops to the floor where it races across the room in a chilling draft.

The only cure is proper insulation that will keep the walls warm. For families planning to build a home, bats or blankets of mineral wool insulation should be installed.

## Changes in Faculty Announced by MSUO

Five faculty members and an assistant dean of students have been appointed to the staff of Michigan State University Oakland.

Dr. Harvey Burdick, 36, who has a Ph.D. from University of Minnesota and a B.A. from Syracuse University, was named associate professor of psychology. Burdick has been at Smith College since 1955, two years as an instructor and the last five as an assistant professor.

Theodore Becker, 29, who will receive his Ph.D. next month from Northwestern University, was named assistant professor of psychology in the 1959-60 academic year, was a visiting lecturer at University of

London's Royal Holloway College. Dr. Paul Tipler, 29, who has Ph.D. and M.S. degrees from University of Illinois, and a B.S. from Purdue University, was named assistant professor of physics. He formerly taught at Illinois and at Wesleyan University.

Arnold Seiken, 34, was named assistant professor of mathematics. Holder of an M.A. from University of Michigan, and a B.A. from Syracuse University, Seiken first was appointed to the MSUO staff last September as a lecturer. He formerly taught at Southern Illinois University and was a teaching fellow and research assistant at U of M. He will receive his Ph.D. this winter from U of M.

Dr. Robert Holmes, 33, assistant professor of music and musicology at MSUO since September, 1960, is the new assistant dean of students. Holmes' Ph.D., M.A. and bachelor's degree in music degrees are from Boston

## Bridge Freeway Gap with Signs

The State Highway Department is using signs to bridge an 85-mile gap in the Interstate 75 Freeway. State Highway Commissioner John C. Mackie said 1-75 signs have been put up along US-10 and US-27 freeways between Bay City and Grayling.

Mackie said the Interstate signs, which are in addition to US-10 and US-27 route markers, will aid motorists following I-75 signs at University.
