All residents of Meadowlake are invited to participate in entertaining these foreign students. Anyone interested should call

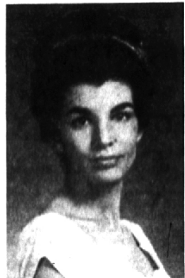
