

B'ham Summer School Sets Enrollment High

The expanded summer school program of the Birmingham Public Schools reached an all-time high enrollment of 1,400 this year. Some 600 elementary children and 930 secondary students attended and, in addition, 540 students were enrolled in driver training.

James Liddle, sixth grade teacher at Pembroke School, was director of the elementary summer program in which 23 Birmingham teachers participated.

Thirty per cent of the 560 students were enrolled in enrichment courses, that is, they were taking courses for the first time. Of the total elementary enrollment, 60 students do not attend Birmingham schools.

The elementary program began in 1950 with about 100 students enrolled in a remedial reading program. Last year, the program was expanded to include arithmetic and typing and the enrollment totaled 397 students. This year, additional enrichment courses were included. A summary of the enrollment included arithmetic, 161 students; enriched reading, 26; remedial reading 205; French, 8; science, 19; typing, 55; youth fitness, 61; speech correction, 25.

CHARLES BULL, English teacher at Seaholm High School, was director of the secondary program in which 36 Birmingham teachers participated.

Since 1950, when the secondary summer program first started, the enrollment has more than doubled. This year about 61 per cent of the 530 students were enrolled in advanced and enrichment courses. Of the total number of students,

Zoning Dispute Settled by Judge At 4th Hearing

A Beverly Hills dentist finally has won the use of a building in Oak Park for his office, after Circuit Court Judge William J. Beer ruled against the results of a third Oak Park zoning board hearing.

The request of Dr. Edward Jamian, 30255 Vernon, to use a building at Kipling and Nine Mile Road in Oak Park was first turned down by the board of zoning appeals last year. Dr. Jamian wanted to buy the building but it lacked four of the required 15 parking spaces.

ON NOV. 28, the board ruled for Dr. Jamian but Dr. Louis L. Kasdan, from who Dr. Jamian had been renting space in another building, objected. Dr. Kasdan said he had not been notified of either of the two zoning board meetings.

MEANWHILE, Dr. Jamian had purchased the building for \$32,000, seven days after the second hearing. The notification error was not brought to light until another six days had passed.

At a third hearing, the zoning board reversed its permission to use the building by a split vote of 3-3 and Dr. Jamian took the matter to Circuit Court.

The zoning board was told by the Judge that it cannot itself correct an error in its procedure because the five-day legal period for such correction had already passed.
