Campaign Manager Says Recount Action Appears Unlikely
 A recount in the Democratic primary election for drain commissioner by Daniel T. Berry appears unlikely, his campaign manager said Monday. Carl O'Brien, Berry's campaign manager, said it appears unlikely his candidate can pick up the necessary votes in a recount. Berry lost to Roy J. Russell by 83 votes, 7,398 to 7,315, according to final results of an election canvass completed last week.

O'BRIEN SAID, however, that a final decision on a recount has not yet been made. He said that Berry is primarily concerned with results in Springfield Township and in Royal Oak Township.

Chrysler Engineering Promotes 3 Area Men
 The appointments of an executive engineer and two chief engineers in Chrysler Corp.'s Engineering Division were announced today by Paul C. Ackerman, vice president-Engineering.
 Named as executive engineer is James W. Shank, 19100 Warwick, Beverly Hills, who will be responsible for the Body Engineering Section. Also appointed were Robert M. Sinclair as chief engineer of body shops and section administration, and Burton H. Bouwkamp as chief engineer of vehicle planning.
 Shank succeeds Clifford B. Doty who is retiring after 42 years with Chrysler Corp. and the Briggs Manufacturing Co.
 In his new position, Shank will be responsible for overall direction of design and development activities associated with the automobile body—its components, trim and electrical equipment. He will be a member of the Engineering Executive Committee. He had been chief engineer of body engineering since 1955.
 SINCLAIR, formerly chief engineer of vehicle planning, now will be responsible for the operation of the body shops, die model shops, and the body operations staff under the direction of Mr. Shank. He is a 1950 graduate of the Carnegie Institute of Technology and lives at 1052 Rock Spring, Bloomfield Township.
 Prior to his assignment as chief engineer of vehicle planning, Bouwkamp, 16207 Wetherly, Beverly Hills, was manager of Chrysler product planning on the corporate Product Planning and Cost Estimating Staff. He received two bachelor degrees from the University of Illinois—one in 1947 in naval mechanical engineering. He was awarded a master of automotive engineering degree from the Chrysler Institute of Engineering in 1951.
