Initiate a new mathematics program and add one classroom. French will be taught after school and several science clubs will also meet after school hours.

ON THE PRIVATE school level, Detroit Country Day will expand its 6th, 7th and 8th grades with 25 teachers on the overall staff. French will be taught to children from the 2nd through the 12th grade.

Bloomfield Country Day will initiate a language lab and increase visual aids for teaching French as well as give beginning instruction in algebra to eighth graders. Algebra was previously first taught at the ninth grade level.

ELEVEN TEACHERS are on the staff at Bloomfield. The school also is making additions to its playground.

City and Country School will add another second grade class to reduce the size of class loads at this level. It is also reorganizing its playground area with new equipment for the physical fitness program. The school employs 15 full-time and 11 part-time teachers and serves children with an IQ of 130 or higher.

SACRED HEART has students from the 1st through the 12th grade in junior, lower senior and senior schools. Emphasis is given courses in language, mathematics and science as well as in sports and games.

Cranbrook, Kingswood and Brookside students are taught by about 80 teachers, 36 of whom are at Cranbrook and another 36 at Kingswood. It is a non-tax supported school.

## Routes and Times Of B'ham Buses

Bus routes and pick-up times for the junior and senior high students of the Birmingham Public Schools will remain the same as last year.

The elementary routes will also remain basically the same. Since the children of Bloomfield Village, Franklin, Pembroke, and Walnut Lake will be attending their home school, no transportation will be involved.

Children who plan to attend the Meadow Lake School when it is completed (tentatively Nov. 1) will be temporarily transported to Midvale, Walnut Lake and Valley Woods Schools.

Parents of Meadow Lake School children may obtain further information by contacting the building principal, Albert Schumm at MI 4-9300.

Residents new to the Birmingham System should check with

their neighbors for information on where the school bus stops to pick up the children. Further information may be obtained by contacting the local school principal.

REGULAR CLASSES at Seaholm and Derby High Schools will begin at 7:55 a.m. and will be dismissed at 3:20 p.m. Most school buses will start their runs at 7:30 a.m.

At Groves, classes will start at 8:25 a.m. and end at 3:50 p.m. Buses will begin picking up students at about 8:00 a.m.

At all grade schools except Bloomfield, Baldwin and Midvale, classes will begin at 8:55 a.m. and end at 2:50 p.m. with buses beginning their runs about 8:30 a.m. At Bloomfield, Baldwin and Midvale schools, classes will be dismissed at 3:10 p.m.

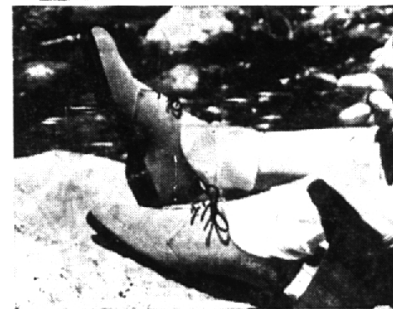
