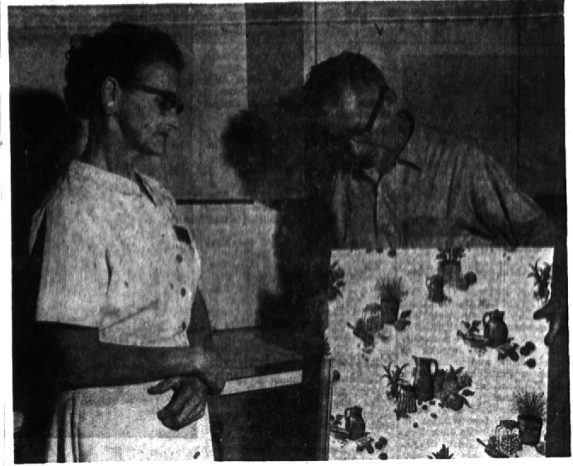
To Recommend Higher Budget For County

A revised budget figure of \$15,536,902 will be offered to the Oakland County Board of Supervisors Sept. 10 by its ways and means committee. The figure, which represents an increase of \$691,902 over last year's budget, was revised when the County Board of Auditors revised their estimate of the county's anticipated total income next year. They had originally set a figure of \$15,412,643.

THE CHANGED estimate was based in part upon an additional \$93,051 in tax revenues, the anticipated result of slightly higher equalized property valuations. The rest of the difference is expected to come from increased receipts derived from such sources as licenses, court services and state matching funds for various county expenditures such as welfare.
