Major Roger B. Sonneborn of the United States Air Force, political science officer of the air arm, will address the Detroit Country Day School Forum Friday afternoon.

Major Sonneborn will speak to the student body on "The Cuban Crisis, Was the Air Force Ready?"

The usual opportunity for questions to the speaker by any member of the Forum will follow. Major Sonneborn is a native of Michigan, a graduate of How Military School, Michigan Tech and Ohio State University. He has eighty hours of combat service in World War II, flying C-47's on paratroop missions over Normandy, Holland and Southern France, following which he was awarded the Air Medal with Oak Leaf clusters.

After the war Major Sonneborn served several years in Germany and more recently has spent over two years flying C-124's in the Far East.

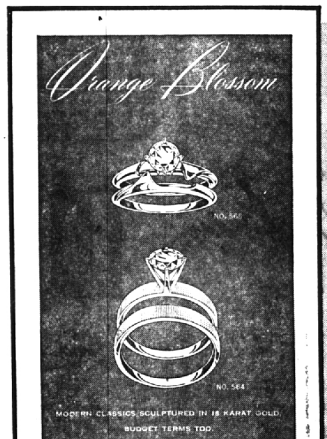

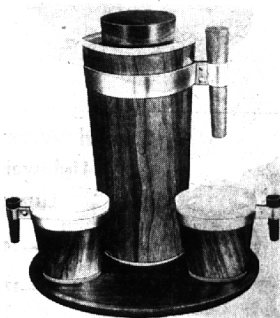

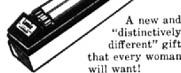
