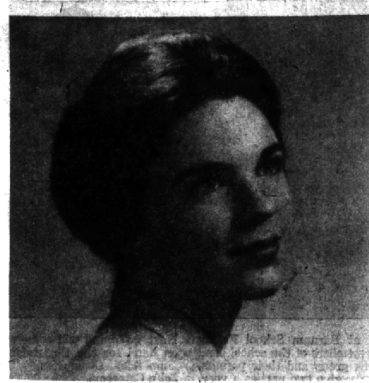

On Tuesday at 8 p.m. in the gymnasium the annual Birney holiday program will be held.

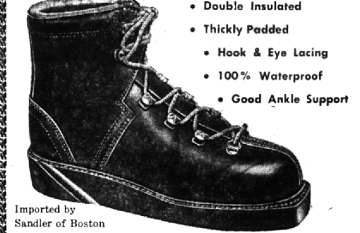


## Winter Wedding Planned

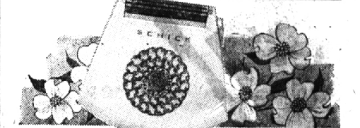

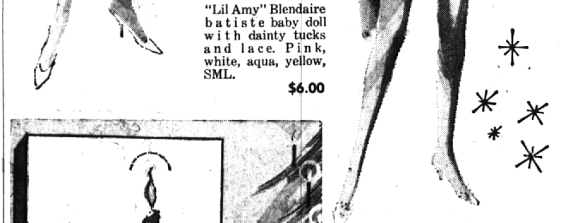
