



Scouts Leaders Confer

Over 200 key volunteer leaders of the Detroit Area Council, Boy Scouts of America, participated in the 1962 District Scouters' Conference Dec. 1 at the Reynolds Metals Office Building, Northwestern at 8-Mile Road. Theme for the conference was "Project Purpose" which, according to F. Lloyd Smith, executive board member of the council and chairman of the conference, is a program of emphasis designed to meet the needs and desires of the nearly 90,000 Scouts and adult leaders currently active in the Detroit area Scouting program. Traffic Hazards High This Month, Hare Says

When the sun starts to set, turn on your automobile lights. That is winter advice to motorists from James M. Hare, chairman of the Michigan State Safety Commission.

A study of urban and rural fatalities in Michigan over a five-year period shows that December is the deadliest month of the year with 10.1 per cent of all traffic deaths.

"Michigan lies in a latitude where the sun sets early in winter," Hare reminded motorists. "On Christmas eve, for example, the

sun drops over the horizon between 4:25 and 4:39 in the afternoon. The variation in the time of sunset is due to the difference in latitude between our southern tier of counties and the upper part of the State."

HARE POINTED out that many December and January accidents happen in the morning when the sun rises much later than at other times of the year. On the 45 degree north latitude, which cuts across the state on a line roughly between Alpena and Traverse City,

the sun rises on New Year's morning at about 7:38. Because of this and other factors like morning fog, the need for driving with lights on during the early hours of the day is most important.

The greatest number of fatal and injury accidents on Michigan's rural and urban roads occurs between 4 and 5 p.m.

Last year 1,707 injury-death accidents took place on rural roads while 511 were suffered on streets in urban areas.
