3 Students Win 'Creative' Scholarships

Three Birmingham youths are among 16 high school seniors who may attend college next fall under "Scholarships for the Creative," a unique Michigan State University program.

They are: in art and sculpture—Dawn Martin, 1928 E. Maple, Seaholm High School; in creative writing—Patricia J. Keogh, 124 S. Williamsbury, Seaholm High School; in music composition—Carol M. Johnson, 17178 Kirkshire, Groves High School.

The program, now in its second year, is designed to give truly creative students who are not necessarily outstanding academically, the opportunity to get a college education.

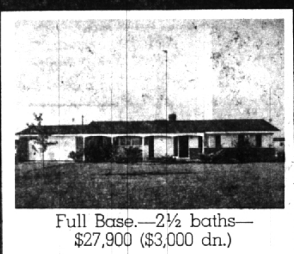
SCHOLARSHIPS ARE given in acting, art and sculpture, creative writing and music composition.

To compete, an applicant must be a Michigan high school senior admitted to MSU and must have need of financial aid. Students are not required to demonstrate academic ability above that required for regular admission to MSU.

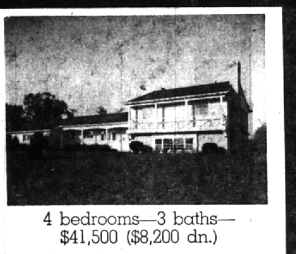
Applicants submit samples of their creative efforts to one of four MSU faculty committees for judging. Auditions in the acting competition are held on the MSU campus.

This year, 150 high school seniors competed for the awards. Winners included three in acting, four in art and sculpture, six in creative writing and three in music composition.

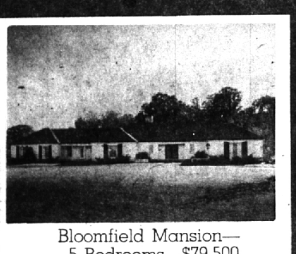

decisions, and using a mass of facts it has been previously fed on the firm's histories and on national economic trends, it calculates in a few minutes the answers it would take a covey of mathematicians and economists days to work out.

But the game is not just a faculty plaything. MSUO students are playing it as part of their course work. The game not only demands that they know something about economics, it also teaches them to use their heads, and gives them an appreciation of the value of the theory they learn in class.

INDEED, IT is considered so valuable (and so much fun for the profs) that there is going to be competition between student and faculty teams. Naturally, if a student team wins, there'll be A's for the course all round.

The game is the creation of Dr. John Van Tassel, Boston College, economics professor, who compiled the ground rules and laid out the detailed programming instructions for the computer.

THE SAME principle in another form helped win World War II. The Joint Chiefs of Staff played it for keeps to resolve extremely intricate strategic problems of world combat and logistics.

While the computer some day may take over the company president's chair, it hasn't yet gotten into the executive suite. Industry today uses the computer to provide the groundwork for a lot of basic decisions and for plotting the most efficient way of scheduling a production process.

BUT AT MSUO, it is more exciting than chess and has been suggested as another form of inter-collegiate competition. In the meantime, says psychologist Hillman, "this all goes to show that business does not live by economics alone."

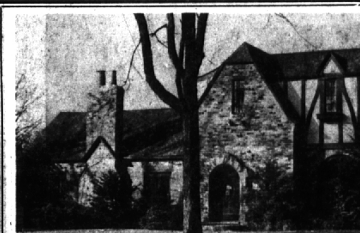
