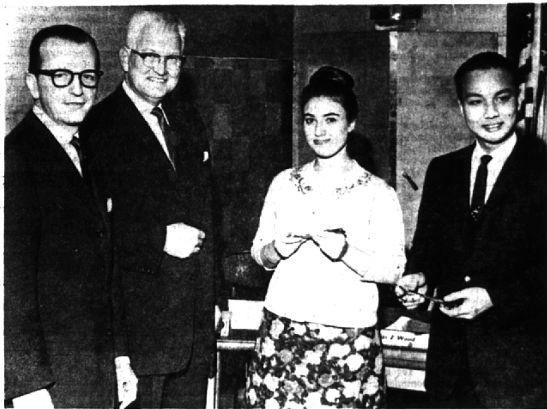




Area Honors Exchange Students

Rec Director May Be Hired in B'field Hills

A full time recreation director will be hired next year to develop school property fronting on Walnut Lake for summer time recreational use. The board of directors of the school district's recreation committee decided that a recreation director would be appointed as a permanent agency to handle planning. It agreed with the committee's recommendation that the program should be expanded to a year round basis. The board appropriated \$1200 for the salary of a part time recreation director and \$500 for equipment as an interim step in development of the program.

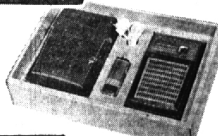

Four Hearings On Rezoning Requests Set

Birmingham city commissioners have scheduled four public hearings for Feb. 11 to hear requests for rezoning in various areas of the city.

The commission also voted Monday night to deny a request to rezone lots 29 and 30 of the Adams Park subdivision from B-2 (neighborhood business) to B-3 (community business).

The commission made the denial on the recommendation of the planning board. The planners had felt there was no need for B-3 zoned land in the Webster Adams area and that the change would constitute a spot rezoning.

It was also felt that although the area has a substantial amount of B-3 property it is developed with uses that are permitted not only in B-3 but also in B-2 zone classification.

A HEARING WILL be held to determine if the property at 707 Knox should be rezoned from its present parking classification to single family residential (R-2). The property is currently being used in an R-2 capacity but is paying taxes on the parking classification. The petitioner, Carl Barton, told the commission that he is paying almost three times the taxes than he would if the property were R-2.

The commission will hold a hearing on a request from Dr. A. L. McNaughton to rezone lot 28 of the Castle Addition subdivision at Southfield and Townsend from its present R-7 (multiple-family) to a B-1 (non-retail business) classification.

Dr. McNaughton proposes to build a clinic on the site. The planning department says that a doctor's office could presently be developed with the existing zoning classification.

The Birmingham zoning ordinance states that multiple family uses may have an office within the structure, providing the floor space of the office is 25 per cent or less

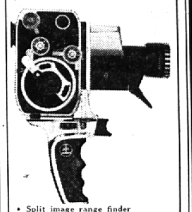
