Miss Ethel J. Bassett, 684 Lakeview, began her 51st year behind the prescription window at Shain's Drug Store May 17. Miss Bassett, a life-long resident of Birmingham, began working at the pharmacy as a summer temporary employe in 1912 and has never been told her job has terminated. She became the first registered woman pharmacist in Oakland County in 1919. Mayor Florence H. Willett and city commissioners proclaimed Wednesday, May 17, 1962, "Ethel J. Bassett Day" in Birmingham.




