The board also adopted a uniform building code as promulgated by the Building Officials Conference of America, abridged edition. The township has not previously been operating under the code for the past few years.

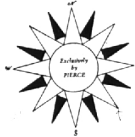

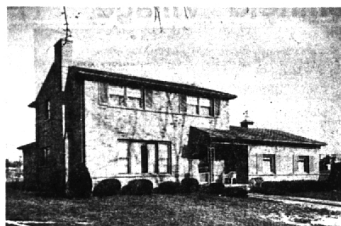

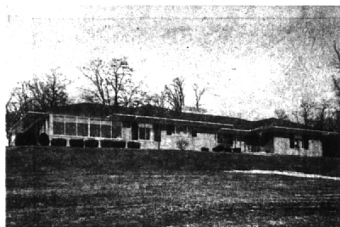
