This photo map shows the location of Stony Creek Metropolitan Park. The arrow and star point to the general location of the park, a 3,000-acre recreational site under development astride the Oakland-Macomb county line. Located three miles northeast of Rochester, it is close to Utica and Romeo in Macomb County. A unit of the Huron-Clinton Metropolitan Authority, the future park site is expected to be open for limited public use in 1964. It will have a 700-acre lake with facilities for boating, fishing, swimming, picnic areas, roads for scenic drives, nature trails, a nature center and a winter sports area.

Award \$114,000 Contract For Stony Creek Park

The Huron-Clinton Metropolitan Authority Board of Commissioners has awarded a contract for \$114,000 for the removal of trees and other natural vegetation covering an area approximately one square mile that will become the lake bottom in Stony Creek Metropolitan Park. A new recreational site under development astride the Oakland-Macomb County line, the park is located three miles northeast of Rochester.

Kenneth L. Hallenbeck, authority director, said that the preparation of plans and taking of bids at this time as required by public agencies, was accelerated to help stimulate employment and develop the park so that it might be opened for limited public use in 1964.

The contract for land clearing was awarded to Harold Dean and Sons, 21812 Nine Mile Road, St. Clair Shores. Since much of this work is suitable for clearing while the ground is frozen, work is expected to begin immediately.

A SECOND CONTRACT for \$198,000 was awarded at the Authority Commission Dec. 14 for the construction of 4.65 miles of interior park road located between 26 Mile Road and Mt. Vernon Road. This contract was awarded to H. C. Shingledacker, 2339 Orchard Lake Road, Pontiac.

Stony Creek Metropolitan Park will cover over 3,000 acres when completed, and will feature a 700-acre lake extending northeast between 26 and 28 Mile Roads. Recreation facilities will include space for boating, fishing, swimming, picnic areas, roads for scenic drives, nature trails, winter sports areas and a Nature Center.

THE AUTHORITY was created in 1940 to provide park and parkways for the counties of Livingston, Macomb, Oakland, Washtenaw and Wayne. The seven-member board of commissioners include Charles H. Sutton, Livingston County; Arthur Mills, Macomb County; R. Clare Cummings, Oakland County; Herbert L. Frisner, Washtenaw County; and William E. Kreeger, Wayne County, each

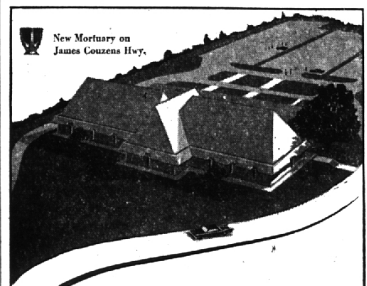

Solution Reached To Dirt Problem

A solution has been reached to the dirt-hauling problem in the Wallace Park Subdivision. Birmingham city commissioners Tuesday night gave owner Fredrick Henkel until 5 p.m. Jan. 12 to complete the hauling of fill dirt for his property.

Neighbors in the area had complained that the operation was a nuisance that had been persistent for the past five years. At its meeting on Oct. 30, 1961, the commission ordered the operation halted until an agreement could be reached.

Tuesday night, they accepted a proposal from Henkel's attorney, Raymond D. Munde. He said the filling can be completed in one major hauling of about 7,000 yards of fill dirt, available Wednesday and today. He said seven or eight days would be needed for the hauling.
