Missionaries Prepare For Return to Congo

After a year's furlough of speaking in about 100 churches throughout the United States, Birmingham First Methodist missionaries Dr. and Mrs. Robert White are preparing to take up new assignments in the Congo.

DR. WHITE will be teaching future public health officers in the newly formed Congo Polytechnic Institute while also practicing medicine.

Established in the spring of 1960, the institute is sponsored by the Congo Protestant Council which represents 42 mission societies.

"THE PRIMARY goal of the institute," said Dr. White, "is to help this young, independent country stand on its own two feet."

At present, there are only 16 university graduates in the Congo which has a population of 14 million.
