Con-Con Report

Marathon Session on Tap

LANSING—The Constitutional Convention's Committee on Local Government goes into a marathon weekend session Friday determined to continue working until it has finalized the major portion of its work.

Committee Chairman Arthur G. Elliott, Jr. (R., Pleasant Ridge), said his committee voted to begin final deliberations immediately after the general convention session Friday.

"We'll meet Friday evening and all day Saturday and Sunday, with time out for church in an effort to identify and resolve most of our problems," he said.

When the committee reports back to the convention Monday, "we hope to have a complete local government package. All that will remain will be to put it in drafted form," Elliott said. He said he anticipates "some difficulty" in reaching agreement on constitutional provisions on county and township home rule and annexation.

"But I am confident that members will submerge their personal opinions and cooperate in writing a local government article that will stand the test of decades to come," he said.

MEANTIME, THE Committee on Rights, Suffrage and Elections moved closer to the completion of its work today.

Chairman James K. Pollock (R., Ann Arbor) said he anticipates that all committee proposals will be completed within two weeks.

A revised basic Declaration of Rights, which the Committee completed prior to the Christmas recess, is being worked over by other committees which have concurrent jurisdiction on certain provisions.

Pollock expressed doubt that the committee would recommend any action to lower the present voting age requirement.

"There has been some discussion of such a possibility, but I doubt there is sufficient sentiment to see it through," he explained.

But Pollock said it is "very probable" that the committee would eliminate from the Constitution the present biennial election, which has been a target of criticism from both major parties.

One proposal before the committee calls for replacing the spring election with a regular annual election in November. "But there is no clear pattern of thinking on the matter as of yet," Pollock said.

Cars Coming Faster Than The Streets

"At the present moment we have about 270,000 miles of registered vehicles in the country and about 380,000 miles of city streets.

"And the automobiles are increasing five times faster than the streets. Mathematically, it seems the moment of complete immobility is not far off, and the parking problem will be solved forever."

So said J. C. Owen and C. A. Smith in a paper presented at Cohe Hall during the five-day 1962 SAE Automotive Engineering Congress and Exposition.

Although the foregoing was a "tongue-in-cheek" look at what might happen, it is part of a serious presentation entitled "The Transportation Dilemma of Greater Metropolitan Areas."

THE AUTHORS point to a sickness they say exists in all mass transit systems. They suggest as a solution a central agency equipped with information, funds and authority to make plans and implement them. They suggest that the rapid transit vehicle of the future might "take the form of an aerodynamic motorcar, a captive plane, which would offer speed superior to anything attainable upon a freeway plus the glamour and the symbolism of the air age."
