

Ingraham Clarifies Role As a County Supervisor

Birmingham City Commissioner Carl Ingraham explained his "conception of my role as a supervisor" at Monday night's commission meeting.

Ingraham was prompted by an editorial, headlined "Exploring Supervisor Problem," in last week's Birmingham Eccentric.

Assuming (correctly) that a statement in that editorial to him, he said it "either reflected a misinterpretation of what I said or a lack of clarity in me as to what I meant."

The statement he mentioned was: "A local supervisor said at a recent city commission meeting that when he acts as a county supervisor he represents the county, and not the City of Birmingham."

INGRAHAM POINTED out that prior to a hearing by the board of supervisor's Legislative Committee,

of which he is a member, it was suggested that he explain Birmingham's view of the tax exemption legislation to that committee.

He asked that someone else give the City's views.

"What sits on a committee of the board of supervisors, he said Monday, he takes the County's position, rather than the City's."

A committee holding a hearing must make recommendations to serve the county as a whole, he asserted.

His position on a committee differs from that when he's sitting on the board of supervisors.

As a supervisor, he is "certified" to Birmingham.

INGRAHAM SAID 95 per cent of the business coming before the supervisors is of a county-wide nature.

"We try to orient ourselves on

what is best for the county."

But when it comes to items of "specific and direct" interest to Birmingham, the entire Birmingham delegation (four supervisors) presents Birmingham's position, Ingraham stated.

He said the local delegation sits together at supervisors' meetings and discusses among themselves as to what is good for Birmingham.

They usually "come to an agreement and support" that position, he said.

Refer Zoning Request to Plan Board

An application to rezone property on Grant St. near Davis in the James L. Todd & Leinbach Humphrey Indian Village Subdivision has been referred to the Birmingham Plan Board.

Petitioning for the Leinbach Humphrey Co., 1692 S. Woodward, Birmingham, R. Gordon Burbridge asked for a rezoning from single residential to multiple residential for 23 through 32 lots in the subdivision.

"THIS PROPERTY," he said, "has access to a public thoroughfare for only one of the 10 planned lots and therefore cannot be developed with single residences."

Multiple dwelling units, he said, would be advantageous to the City and to the developer as a long-term investment.

City commissioners voted unanimously to refer the application to the plan board for study and recommendation.

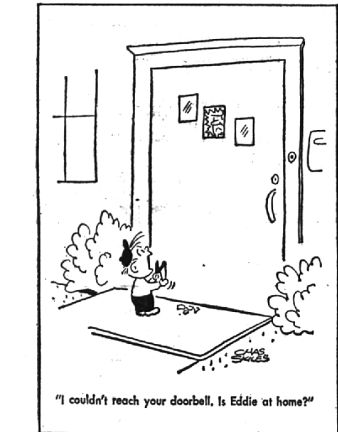
Tax Form Is Available

The Internal Revenue Service reminds taxpayers about the new two page Form 1040 which combines the better features of the 1960 Form 1040 and the discontinued Form 1040W.

R. I. Nixon, district director of Internal Revenue, announced that page one of the new Form 1040 provides space for listing the sources of income, computation of tax, a listing of tax payments and credits, and a computation of tax due or refund. The director added that page two provides a schedule for listing exceptions and various schedules for itemizing deductions.

It was further noted that schedules for reporting various types of income, which previously appeared on pages 3 and 4 of the Form 1040, will be contained in a separate Schedule B for 1961. This schedule need only be completed and attached to the Form 1040 when required.

Nixon feels that the revised Form 1040 should make the preparation of tax returns much easier for those individuals who previously filed on Forms 1040 and 1040W.



CITY OF BIRMINGHAM, MICHIGAN NOTICE SERVICEMEN AND VETERANS HOMESTEAD TAX EXEMPTION

IF YOU ARE:

1. A veteran of the Spanish American War.
2. A veteran of World War No. 1 and have a service or non service connected disability recognized by the United States Veterans Administration upon which compensation is paid.
3. An active service man.
4. A veteran of World War No. II who has a service or non service connected disability recognized by the United States Veterans Administration upon which compensation is paid.
5. Unremarried widow of any of above.
6. Resident of State at least 6 months prior to service.
7. Resident of State 5 years prior to filing affidavit.

THEN YOU ARE entitled to homestead tax exemption on \$2,000 of assessed value, PROVIDED: on January 1, 1962, you owned and occupied the property as a homestead, did not own property assessed at more than \$7,500, make application before March 1, 1962.

Application may be made at the office of the City Assessor, Municipal Building, who will assist you.

BRING deed or land contract, discharge papers, recent proof of receiving compensation for service or non service connected disability, if you are receiving same.

We respectfully suggest that application be made as soon after January 1st as possible.
