 - CALCIUM CHLORIDE (DOW FLAKES)—Better than salt, particularly at temperatures lower than 15 to 20 degrees Fahrenheit. Goes further than salt. \$3.70/cwt.
 - 55. N.2—A special chemical which melts ice 30 times faster than salt. It goes right through and spreads out under the ice, lossening it from the surface. Re-moval of ice is then very simple. Use sparingly. Especially nice on porches, steps, and walks. 10 lbs. (\$1.50; 25 lbs. (\$3.50.
