Two Hurt As Car Hits Fire Engine

LATHRUP — A Lathrup woman and a Southfield fireman were injured Monday night at 8:55 when the woman's car struck a fire engine at Southfield and 12 Mile Roads. The fire engine was en route to a fire.

Barbara Radenber, 23, of 17611 Ramsgate, suffered a bruised left knee and chin.

Matthew MacKenzie, 41, of 28727 Pierce, Southfield, suffered a bumped head.

Both Barbara and MacKenzie were treated and released from William Beaumont Hospital.

SOUTHFIELD FIREMEN said the engine, from Station Three, was traveling east on 12 Mile Road, en route to a garage at the home of Leonard Schubert, 30566 Briarwood, Southfield. The engine was struck at the intersection by Barbara's car, headed south on Southfield Road, and then veered into a ditch.

Meanwhile, police from Southfield used a fire extinguisher on Schubert's car, keeping the blaze under control until firemen from Southfield Station One arrived to put the car fire out. Damage to Schubert's car, a 1957 Plymouth, was estimated at about \$500, firemen said. Cause of the fire was not known.

DAMAGE to the fire truck has not yet been estimated though it is believed to be minor, firemen said. Lathrup and Beverly police assisted Southfield police at the scene of the accident.

Two Lathrup Homes On Same Street Looted by Burglars

LATHRUP — Two Lathrup residences were burglarized between 4:30 and 9:30 p.m. on Jan. 8. The burglaries were the first in "90 or 100 months," according to Police Chief Tom Telford.

The home of David Redwood, 15751 San Rosa was broken into and \$95 in cash, a .32 caliber revolver and a box of bullets taken. At the home of Robert Karr, across the street at 17570 San Rosa, three bottles of whiskey were stolen.

The police chief said both homes were entered through rear windows which were broken by the burglars. The owners were away when the burglaries occurred.
