IN ACCEPTING the awards,

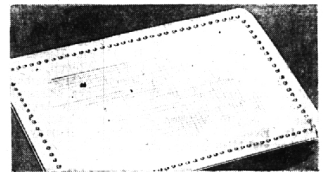

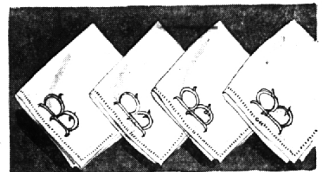

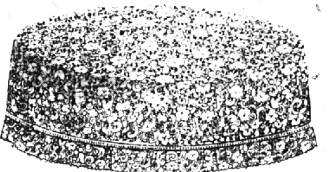
