B'ham OK's Contract for Planning Job

A contract with the planning consultant firm of Vilcan-Leman & Associates, Inc., to carry out work under a Federal grant was approved by Birmingham city commissioners Monday night.

The contract is a tri-party agreement between the City, the State and Vilcan-Leman, a Southfield

company, to carry out the so-called "101 Program."

The Federal Government has granted Birmingham \$22,630 for preliminary planning work leading up to a comprehensive master plan.

INCLUDED IN the program are such planning activities as topographical maps and aerial photographs.

Terms of the contract call for completion within two years.

Commissioners Carl F. Ingraham and Ralph A. Main, opposed to use of Federal funds for such local projects, voted against approval of the contract.

Decision Near On CD Aide

Birmingham is expected to hire a civil defense administrative aide within the next three weeks.

Assistant City Manager R. S. Kenning informed the city commission Monday night that eight applications have been received to date for the position.

Interviews and investigations will be made before a decision is reached, Kenning said. Kenning is

in charge of City personnel.

AT THEIR Dec. 26 meeting, commissioners made the city manager responsible for civil defense and authorized hiring of an administrative aide to his office to actually perform the work.

Kenning has been serving as director of civil defense on a part-time basis.

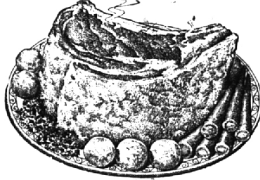
