

# Marshall Named B'ham Unitarian Interim Minister

Robert Marshall, Ann Arbor bookstore owner, has been appointed Interim Minister of the Birmingham Unitarian Church. He succeeds Rev. Lester Moudale who recently resigned.

Although trained as a congregational minister at the Chicago Theological Seminary, Marshall

has for several years been engaged part-time in the Unitarian Ministry. During the past year he has been interim minister for the Universal Unitarian Church at Horton, Michigan.

HE HAS also served as guest minister at various Unitarian churches in Southeastern Michigan. He has been an active speaker before campus and community groups in the Ann Arbor area.

Mr. Marshall owns and operates Michigan's largest bookstore, "Bob Marshall Book Shops." The principal shop is in Ann Arbor. There is a branch in Ypsilanti. In 1948 and 1949 he managed the U.A.W. bookstore in Detroit. He started his own book shop while he was a seminary student in Chicago.

MR. MARSHALL, age 41, is married and has five children. His wife, Doris, is a former psychiatric case worker. The Marshalls are avid gardeners. They spend much of their summer working a 120 acre farm near Ann Arbor in which they have a part interest.

The Marshalls will continue to live in Ann Arbor. Mr. Marshall expects to spend about two days a week in Birmingham.

CHILDREN who have been in the 4 and 5 year old kindergartens in Sunday School this past year will have special attention in groups using the topic, "We Have a Bible."

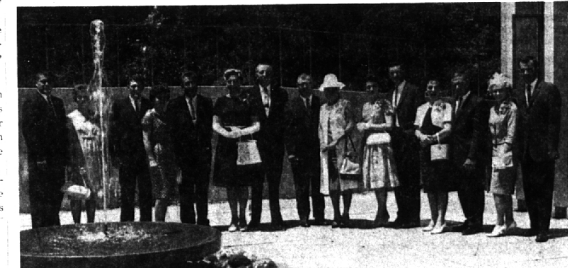
Classes for Primary Grade children will study "Our Bible." The Junior Department boys and girls
