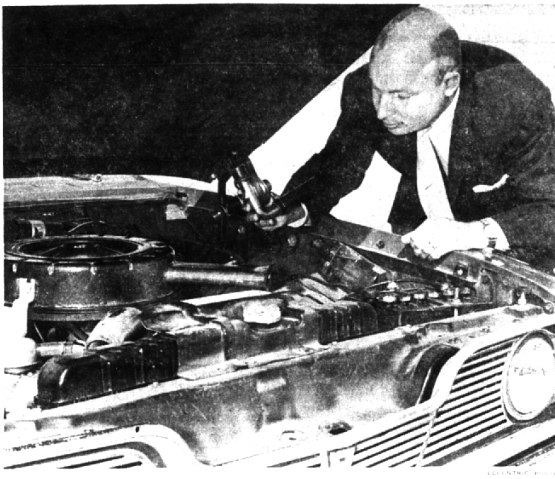

Area Residents Transfer Command

John A. Parks, Jr., of 692 Frank, Birmingham turned over command of Naval Reserve Fleet Division 9-5(D) to Edward X. Tuttle, Jr., of 3081 Northgate Southfield, last Saturday at Broadhead Naval Armory, Detroit.

Parks, who has been selected for promotion to Commander, moves up to a new position in the Naval Reserve.

The Fleet Division trains Naval Reservists to man small ships in the event of national emergency. The five officers and fifty petty officers of the Division cruise on the Great Lakes one weekend every month and take an additional two-week cruise every year.

County Rates High in New Auto Sales

A Michigan Department of State survey shows that 15,691 new cars were sold in Oakland County during the first four months of this year. During the same period 122,218 new automobiles were sold by dealers throughout Michigan.

Secretary of State James M. Hare pointed out that sales of high new and used cars brought in \$27,100,000 in sales and use tax revenue during the first third of the year.

"Fifty," Hare said, "is over six million dollars more than the \$17,065,589 collected during the same period in 1961. This 33 per cent increase points to an unusually high sales year despite the dis-inflation in Wall Street and the ups and downs in other sectors of our economy."

The 1962 VEHICLE taxes were collected on nearly a half million transactions. In the first four months of 1962, 449,477 new and used cars and trucks were sold compared to 326,520 in the same period in 1961.

Hare reported that the average sales tax per item in 1962 was \$17.58, an increase of \$7.31 above the 1961 average of \$9.27. F-taxes per vehicle rose only \$1.47 from \$16.55 in 1961 to \$17.82 in 1962.

A substantial proportion of weight taxes, sales taxes on new and used cars, and gasoline taxes collected within a county is returned by the State to the county in which the taxes are collected.
