

AMENDMENT TO ZONING ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 3.3 OF ORDINANCE NO. 527 OF THE ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF BRIMINGHAM AND THE ZONING MAP, BY ADDITION OF A SECTION TO BE KNOWN AS SECTION 3.2.7.

Section 1. That Section 3.3 of Article 3 of Ordinance No. 527 be amended by addition of a section to be known as Section 3.3-27, bad Section to read as follows:
