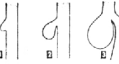

**Diverticulum Means Pouch**



Q. What is an esophageal diverticulum?

A. It is a protrusion of the food passage. (1) In time, the protrusion may enlarge, forming a pouch which may, in turn, be full or empty of fluid or food. (2) Emptying usually occurs without much trouble. (3) A diverticulum continues to enlarge, an obstruction may form. (4) An obstructed diverticulum very often needs surgical correction.

**Pregnancy Possibility**  
Q. Could pregnancy be achieved after removal of the right ovary and left fallopian tube?  
A. Pregnancy has occurred following the removal of one ovary and the opposite tube but this development is of necessity extremely rare. How the ovum or egg gets to the opposite side is a moot question.
