 "LOOK FELLOWS, we've got to have some confidence in the people above us who issue our orders. They know what they're doing."
 "The hell they do."
 The book asks, in various forms, of one human being after another, "are you crazy?" The verdict is always "you're out of your head!"
 For Heller, as for Macbeth's witches, "Fair is foul." But when the witches say "and foul is fair," Heller says "and foul is foul," which is powerfully negative thinking.

ALSO LIKE the witches, Heller's characters "Hover through the fog and filthy air." The filth is black; the fog is bumbleheadedness. Before bombing Bologna, a terrorist pilot secretly advances the map ribbon so that the city appears to have been already captured. News of the 'capture' spreads rapidly.
 "Colonel Cathart was overjoyed, for he was relieved of the embarrassing commitment to bomb Bologna without blemish to the reputation for valor he had earned by volunteering his men to do it."
 GENERAL DREEDLE was pleased with the capture of Bologna, too, although he was angry with Colonel Moodus for waking him up to tell him about it.
 Headquarters was also pleased and decided to award a medal to the officer who had captured the city. There was no giver who had captured the city, so they gave the medal to General Peckem instead, because he was the only officer with sufficient initiative to ask for it.
 IT MAY BE that the appalling implications of nuclear warfare enable us to laugh at the more limited agonies of World War II, but Heller goes much farther. He is a one man grand jury re-

turning a true bill against civilization. (For instance, to the clergy: "You guys haven't had a fresh idea in nineteen hundred and forty four years.")
 Here there is as much pity for widows, orphans, and the mutilated as sharks show for suckers.
 WAR, MEDICINE, religion, business, government, and sex, it turns out, do not exist.
 There is only smug, self-aggrandizing, irrational, ludicrous, depraved man. Love is only the attitude of the hero, Captain Yossarian, panic-ridden bombardier, for every prostitute he meets.
 There is a horrible fascination in "Catch 22" and a laugh on every page, but there is not one joke in the book.
 LAUGHTER IS provoked by incongruity. The source of incongruity is delusion. Delusion comes from sentimentality.
 So Heller makes sentimentality side-splitting to show the entrails of his hapless, flak-happy flyers, and the rest of us.

Jonathan Swift made his concert debut in Paris in 1935. Besides appearances with various symphony orchestras in the U. S., during the past few years, he has sung leading roles with the Michigan Opera Company and the Detroit Opera Theatre.
