used for other purposes, a general coverage receiver is the answer.

AS FAR AS bands are concerned every ham has his or her favorite—ask six hams for their favorite brand name and you will get six answers. Most of the brand names will not be familiar to you because this type of radio is usually built by firms who specialize in only building short wave sets.

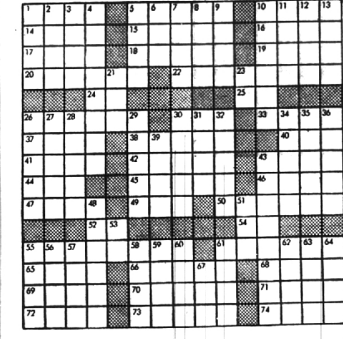
Anything other than a superheterodyne receiver should probably not be considered and if the purse will stand the strain, only a double conversion superheterodyne especially if it is planned to use the set in the crowded amateur bands.

SOME GOOD QUALITY single conversion sets are available and with a little patience they do quite well.

It should be noted that no communication receiver should be considered unless it has at least a three gang tuning condenser. Some sets with only a two gang unit are on the market and are labeled as "communications" receivers. The sacrifice of selectivity for the two gang units is too much of

a price to pay and you would be well advised not to pay it. If you simply ask the dealer whether or not the particular set you are considering has a two or a three gang tuning condenser he will know what you mean, assuming he knows his merchandise.

CONSIDER TOO the possibility of used equipment. There is a lot of it on the market and much of it represents a good buy. For example, it is possible to purchase a good double conversion ham band only receiver used for less than you might pay for a single conversion "general coverage" set.

The important consideration in the purchase of new or used equipment is to first determine your needs and desires and second determine your price range.

THIS, THEN, WILL determine whether you should consider new or used equipment. There is one—and only one—advantage to buying used equipment. It is cheaper.

On the other hand you may be able to own a better set by buying it used. Many hams have all used equipment and swear by it. If in doubt, ask a ham friend to take a look at what interests you. He'll be glad to help.
