Residents to Aid In Starting New Research Center

Photographers have traditionally borne the nickname "Flash" and Birmingham Eccentric lensman Al Mitchell put the label to the test last Friday evening at the Bloomfield Hills Country Club. Fied with zeal, Mitchell was the center of attention for a few moments when he was observed tearing down the wide staircase and through the lobby of the building bearing a burning tree. The flaming foliage was part of the decor at the clubhouse Ball, for graduates of Bloomfield Hills Country Day School. The ornament, white tulle pool, which was accented with tiny pink roses, had gone up in smoke, ignited by a nearby candle. His rescue not done and the tree safely outside, "Flash" went back to snapping pictures—his ears flaming as members paid him glowing tributes.
