Teens enrolling in the Tuesday program are limited to one morning and one afternoon class, but would be free to join the Drop-In activities.

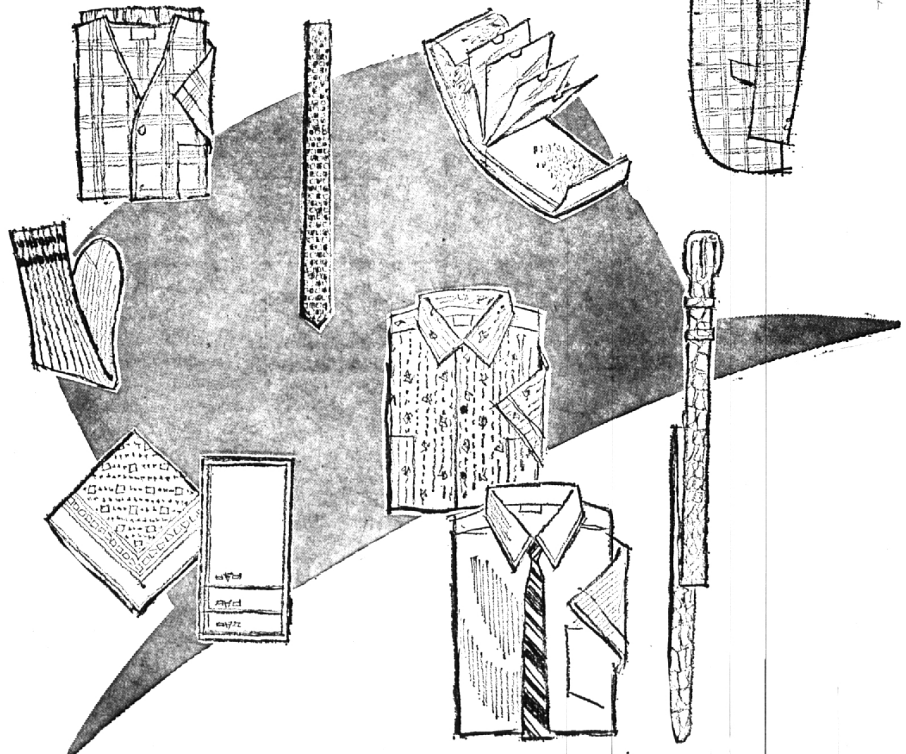
Luncheon Meeting
