B'field Hills Woman To Attend Workshop

Mrs. Vera Muthleb of 18445 Lone Pine Road, Bloomfield Hills, is one of the forty-two teachers in public and parochial schools, police officers and community leaders who are receiving scholarships to attend a summer Workshop on Human Relations.

The scholarship is provided by the Edgar DeWitt Jones Scholarship Fund of the Detroit Round Table at the National Conference of Christians and Jews. She will attend University of Detroit from June 25 through July 30.

Mrs. Muthleb is a social studies teacher at the Pulaeki Elementary School in Detroit. She is a member of the Detroit Teachers Association and the Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority. She is active in Grace Episcopal Church assisting with the direction of the Boy Scout program and teaching Sunday School.

THE PURPOSE of a workshop is to provide intensive periods of study on methods and techniques that help meet and deal more effectively with the problems which arise out of intergroup tensions. They provide the skills and techniques with which harmonious relations among racial, religious, nationality and ethnic groups may be developed in the school and community.

Since the inauguration of this program by the Detroit Round Table 454 Michigan teachers, social workers, police officers, visiting nurses and PTA and community leaders have received scholarships and have returned to their community areas or schools to put into practice their learned skills.
