LOCAL HAM operators are liable to run into Nancy almost anywhere. Not only is she very active on the air but she also travels around the country to attend all sorts of meetings. She rarely misses a Hamvention if it is within 200 miles of Birmingham.

Nancy is considerate of those of us who have stiff wrists and slow minds—she will slow down to our speed if we ask her to.

The first time I saw her, she was operating a station on the tailgate of a station wagon during the 1960 field day exercises.

HER RIG WAS located at Kensington Metropolitan Park and she was operating one of the stations for the local radio club. Her mother was kept busy just writing up her contacts in the station log book.

For a while, Nancy attended the School for the Blind at Lansing. While she was there she kept in almost daily contact with her home by way of her own portable amateur station. In days gone by, this would have been all but impossible because of the cumbersome size of the equipment.

TODAY, HOWEVER, a station can be packed into a suitcase, accounting for the large numbers of portable amateur stations on college campuses all over the country. In fact, many of the schools today have their own amateur stations which have been built under the direction of the science teachers and are operated by the licensed hams who attend the schools.

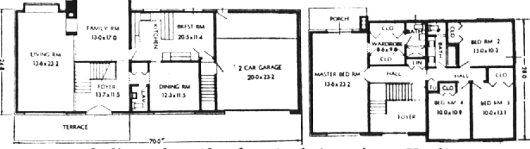
