### VILLAGE OF BEVERLY HILLS ORDINANCE NO. 59

AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR THE METHOD OF GIVING NOTICE OF SDESTA GIVING NOTICE OF SPECIAL ASSESSMENT HEARINGS.

The Village of Beverly Hills Ordains:

Section 1.01. In all cases where Special Assessments are made against property, notice of all hearings in the Special Assessment proceedings shall be given as pro-vided in this Ordinance in addition to any notice of such hearings given by publication or posting as required by statute, ordinance or charter.

Section 2.01. Notice of Hearings in Special Assessment section 2.01. Assessment record means in special Assessment support the last Village tax assessment records, by mailing by first class mail addressed to such owner or party at the address shown on such tax assessment records, at the address shown on such tax assessment records, at the address shown on such tax assessment records, at the last total old ags before the date of such hearing. The last Village tax assessment record means the last assessed roll for ad valorem tax purposes which has been reviewed by the Board of Review, as supplemented by any subsequent changes in the names or the addresses of such owners or parties listed thereon.

Section 3.01. Where any person claims an interest in section 3.01. Where any person ciaims an interest in real property whose name and correct address do not appear upon the last Village 1 ax assessment records, he shall be obligated to file immediately his name and address with the assessor. This requirement shall be deemed effective only for the purpose of establishing a record of names and addresses of those persons entitled record of farmers and numeroses of those persons entitled to notice of hearings in Special Assessment proceedings. It shall be the duty of the assessor to immediately enter on the Village tax assessment records any changes in the names and addresses of owners or parties in interest filled with him and at all times to keep such tax assess-ment records current and complete.

Section 4.01. Any failure to give notice as required Section 4.01. Any failure to give notice as required by this Ordinance shall not invalidate an entire assess-ment roll but only the assessments on property affected by the lack of notice. In no case shall any Special As-sessment be declared invalid as to any property if the owner or said party in interest thereof has actually received notice, has waived notice, or has paid any part of the assessment. If any assessment is declared void by court decree or judgment, a reassessment against the property may be made.

Section 5.01. Each Special Assessment hearing heretofore held is validated insofar as any notice of hearing is fore held is validated insofar as any notice of hearing is concerned, if notice was given by mail to the owners or parties in interest whose names appeared at the time of mailing on the last tax assessment record. Any such spe-cial Assessment hearing is also validated as to any own-er or party in interest who has actually received notice of hearing, has waived such notice, or has paid any part of the Smeid Assessment. of the Special Assessment.

Section 6.01. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be severable. Should any section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase be declared unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, it is hereby provided that the remainder of the Ordinance shall not be affected thereby.

Section 7.01. This Ordinance is adopted pursuant to the authority of Section 11.20 of the Charter of the Vil-lage and Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1452, approved by the Governor on May 10, 1962, and ordered to take immediate

Section 8.01. The provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be immediately necessary for the preservation of public peace, health and safety and shall be effective immediately upon publication.

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
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
