Glacier National Park in north-

western Montana presents a picture of lofty ice fields, rounded, hanging valleys and blue glacial lakes. Yosemite Valley is a small part of the spectacular wilderness in the Sierra Nevada. Its towering granite walls and great leaping waterfalls suggest a magic land of giants.

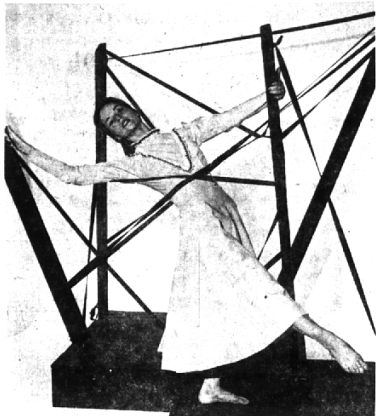
To those who are unable to trek into the wide blue yonder, one's own backyard, patio or heated swimming pool can be a delightful vacation spot, too.

Birmingham newcomers heard Robert Thom speak on his famous history of pharmacy and history of medicine paintings last week.

It was their final luncheon of the year designed around an arts and crafts theme, which included a small exhibit of paintings by members.

Through slides, Thom presented paintings in various stages of completion—from the first charcoal sketch to the finished oil and explained his technical approach.

It was also fascinating to hear the conceptual development of the paintings from the selection of the historical episode to the hiring of models and re-creation of authentic setting.

At each stage the work must be verified by historical experts.

One finished painting which had been approved was discovered to have included Arabic script that was about 300 years ahead of its time. The correction was made.

PAINTED BY THOM for Parke Davis, the pharmacy series (which includes 14 oils and took seven years to complete) has been exhibited all over the world. It was recently seen in Detroit's historical museum.

The current series on the history of medicine is all but finished with only 2 of the 15 paintings to be completed.

A NEW SIX-WEEK theatre school is being offered by MSUCO, the division of continuing education. It began Monday.

Designed for high school and college students as well as adults, the program includes courses in acting, modern dance, show rehearsal and technical theatre production.

Classes will be held every Monday-Friday morning at MSUCO.
