Beverly Hills Resident Wins Forecaster Award

Robert B. Larzere, supervising statistician for Michigan Bell Telephone Co.'s accounting and statistical department, has been named "the most accurate local business activity forecaster for 1961" by the Detroit Area Economic Forum.

The award was presented June 21 at the Forum's monthly meeting. Larzere, who lives at 18224 Elizabeth, Beverly Hills, was more than 98 per cent accurate in predicting business activity in nine out of 15 categories. He averaged 95 per cent accuracy for the entire 15 categories which included auto production, new home construction, banking transactions, industrial sales of electricity, wages, and employment.

The Forum is an organization of local economists representing banks, utilities, government agencies, manufacturers, retailers, newspapers, universities and trade associations.

Lewell N. Mays Named Sales Manager by Chevy

The appointment of Lewell N. Mays as general sales manager of Cadillac Motor Car Division has been announced by Harold G. Warner, Cadillac general manager and vice president of General Motors. The new assignment is effective July 1, 1962.

Mays, of 340 Lakewood, Bloomfield Hills, moves to Cadillac from Chevrolet Motor Division where he has been assistant general sales manager for the western United States. He succeeds Freddie H. Murray who will retire August 31, 1962, under provisions of the General Motors retirement program.

A native of Findlay, Ohio, Mays joined Chevrolet sales organization in 1956 after four years of retail automotive experience. In his rise through the ranks his varied experience has included field positions as district manager, business management, organization, department and distribution.

In 1956, following 11 years in the field, he was promoted to the position of manager of business management and territorial security in Chevrolet central office in Detroit. His later assignments included manager of sales promotion, national used car manager and assistant general sales manager in charge of staff accounting.

Then in 1959 he was named assistant general sales manager for the western United States.

Troy Businessman Helps Open New Manufacturers Bank

A new office of Manufacturers National Bank of Detroit was opened last week on Dequindre near 15 Mile Road, it was announced by William A. Howe, senior vice president.

The office at 2476 Dequindre is Manufacturers' second office located in Sterling Township. The first one on Van Dyke just south of 15 Mile Road was opened in March of this year.

Howe said that the Dequindre Office is currently undergoing remodeling that will result in complete, modern and efficient banking service for the surrounding community.

Second vice president of the bank Allen E. Buchner, who is a resident of Sterling Township, was in charge of the office when it was opened for business by West Gableby Sr. who made the first deposit.

Gableby is president of the A.M.T. Corporation, manufacturer of model automobiles, in Troy, Michigan. Assisting in the proceedings was George N. Memo, who is vice president of the bank and a member of the board of directors at A.M.T.

Grand Trunk RR Shows \$4 Million Deficit in 1961

The Grand Trunk Western Railroad had a deficit of \$4,531,067 before interest from its operations in 1961, the annual meeting of the board of directors was told today by H. A. Sanders, vice-president and general manager.

For the first quarter of 1962 there was a deficit of \$1,281,186 before interest. An improvement of \$1,653,153 over the 1961 first quarter deficit of \$1,781,339. It is anticipated that the improvement will continue through the year, although a deficit is forecast for 1962.

An unpredictable factor in the year's forecast is the labor cost involved in present negotiations with various labor groups, said Sanders.

FRIGHT REVENUES are expected to increase, the major contributors being the increase in

automotive production and the introduction of tri-land equipment for hauling finished automobiles. In the first quarter of the year, 504 tri-level cars were handled by the railroad. A decline in passenger revenues, attributed in part to a decrease in commuter traffic, is forecast however.

During the first quarter of this year, nine new industries were located on GT lines, and six on-line industries have undertaken expansion programs. New equipment on order includes 112 twenty-ton, double-door box cars equipped with cushion underframes, to be delivered in August, and 50 covered hopper cars of 4,000 cubic-foot capacity.

Donald Gordon was re-elected as chairman and president of the CTW at the meeting. Sanders was also re-elected.

Dan Int-Hout, president Michigan Carton Co. of Battle Creek, was elected to the board of directors replacing the late Sherwin A. Hill.
