C. Allen Harlan Receives Award From University

C. Allen Harlan of Birmingham, industrialist, inventor, philanthropist, and civic leader, received the 1961 N. W. Dougherty Award Feb. 23. The award is given each year by the University of Tennessee, college of engineering, to an outstanding leader in the engineering field.

The award, named in honor of the dean emeritus of U-T's engineering college, was presented to Harlan at a banquet in Knoxville. The presentation was made in conjunction with observance of "National Engineers Week."

THE SELECTION of the 1961 award was made by an anonymous committee of professional engineers. A bronze plaque was awarded Harlan at the banquet.

A native of Columbia, Tenn., Harlan attended U-T as a student in the college of engineering. For many years a strong supporter of U-T, Harlan is a recipient of a scholarship aid to financially pressed students in the engineering programs at Knoxville, he has worked actively in educational service as a trustee of Michigan State University, Fisk University, Brandeis University, Marygrove College, Bethany College, and Hampton Institute.

PRESIDENT of Harlan Electric Company, one of the nation's largest electrical contractors, he is also president or director of 10 other affiliated companies.

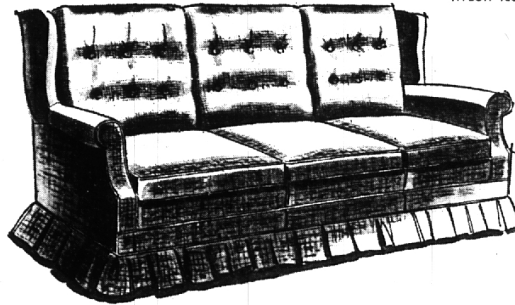

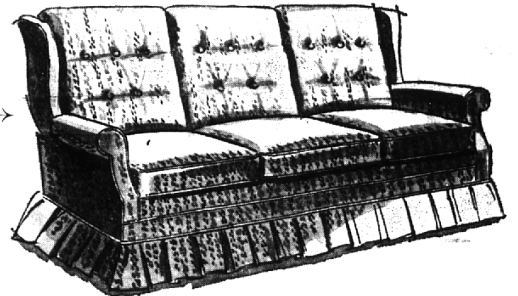
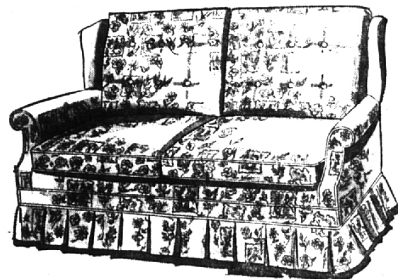
