Birmingham's accident total rose from 62 in January, 1961, to 80 in January of 1962, according to a report issued by Police Chief Ralph W. Mosley.

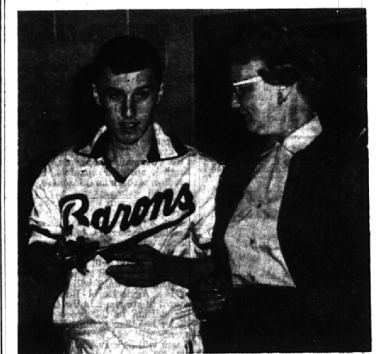

The money was authorized for the Oak St. bridge and paving from Lakeside to Lakepark, \$1,424.59; Northlawn bridge and approaches, \$2,811.12; and the Willits St. culvert and approaches, \$3,050.
