- CHARTER AMENDMENT

  Shall Section 3. Chapter XI, of the Village Charter be amended to read as follows?

  Section 3. The cost of all construction, improvement and maintenance of highways, streets and alleys within the Village shall be paid for in accordance with the general laws of the State governing the construction, improvement and maintenance of highways, streets and alleys within a village. In addition, the Council may determine that the whole, or any part, of the cost of the construction or improvement of highways, streets and alleys within the Village shall be defrayed by special assessment upon the property especially benefited. The Council shall by general ordinance prescribe a complete special assessment procedure.

  And shall Chapter IX of the Village Charter be amended by adding a new Section 11 thereto to read as follows? Section 11. The Council, subject to the applicable provisions of law, may authorize the borrowing of money in anticipation of the payment of special assessments made for the purpose of the construction or improvement of highways, streets and alleys within the Village. Such special assessment should shall be both an obligation of the special assessment should shall be both an obligation of the special assessment in the same are pledged for the payment of the principal of, and interest on, bonds issued in anticipation of the payment of the principal of, and interest on, bonds issued in anticipation of the payment thereof, shall be set apart in a separate fund for the payment of such principal and interest and shall be used for no other purpose.
