HOW THE PLAN WILL WORK

The budget year begins with May and runs through April of the following year. The total amount to be paid for service during the budget year will be estimated on the basis of past usage or other available data. Your monthly service bills then will be approximately one-twelfth of this amount.

During the first part of the budget year, your monthly payments will be somewhat larger than they would be under normal billing. You will thus be building up a credit against the winter months when your use of natural gas or electricity

You will be billed for the same amount each month unless the credit you have built up is insufficient, when combined with the amount of the budget payment, to cover the service used, in which case you will be billed for the amount due. In April you will receive a bill for the amount then re-

maining due, which may well be less than the amount of the monthly budget payment. Small overpayments of a year's bills can be carried over to apply against the next year. Larger overpayments can be refunded.
