corner with the constant development of new and faster aircraft and Metropolitan's \$25,000,000 expansion plan to accommodate air-line traffic pouring from Willow Run by 1964.

By that time the \$35,000,000 airport site lends itself to a further property acquisition stage of its planned 10-year development, the Oakland County Board of Supervisors' proposed airport is intended to supplement Detroit Metropolitan well as to serve South-eastern Michigan.

The Oakland site, selected by J. Robert Swanson, county planning commission chairman and chairman of the airport project approved by the planning commission and board of supervisors' special advisory committee called for a 3,000-acre tract of land one mile north of Pontiac in Orion Township.

Such an airport, according to a seven-month study of Southeastern Michigan air transportation requirements by Landrum & Brown, airport consultants of Cincinnati, Ohio, would require up to a maximum of 6,000 acres.

To date 445 acres, including the 140-acre Allens Airport, a small corporate-type facility between Royal Silver Hill, Gideaux and Lapeer roads, have been purchased.

With the Allens facility serving as the nucleus of the proposed airport, the 3,000-acre site would extend about 2 1/2 miles in each direction from Allens Airport.

Further acquisition of land and the plan for the proposed airport are being delayed pending site approval by the Federal Aviation Agency which determines airport requirements such as direction of runways and air space use.

THUS, WITHOUT a master plan, the airport site must be selected in general preference rather than certainties or specifics.

According to Swanson, the planning commission reviewed and studied all land from Eight Mile Road in Detroit to a point 10 miles beyond Clarkston (Clarkston being about seven miles from the proposed site) before coming up with the present location.

Major considerations in selecting the site were the availability of land for 10,000 to 14,000-foot runways (minimum of two miles long) to handle the largest jets in operation today, and the quality of land.
