 or three secondary arms nearly as large as your arm. They can be cut off abruptly to be the length you desire. Select a large pot or ornamental container and use either plastic paris or cement to "plant" the large branch so it will be substantial.
 AT THE END of each arm hollow out a space where you can place soil as well as the elbows where the arm branches meet the main branch. In the Spring you begin your flower plant tree with pansies.
 Later you could plant butter ball yucca, marigolds, petanias, or tuberose rooted begonias. It would
