Varied Types Of Footwear Available to Men

This Spring foot-conscious fellows will be able to choose between sharply different classics and styled-up types.

This is good news whether the gents are thinking in fashion terms or simply about their arches.

The classics preferred by the natural-shoulder fans with plain toes, wing-tips, straight tips, moccasin fronts and perforated medallion toes remain the traditional favorites, but even these have a lighter, trimmer, more flexible look.

THE STYLED-UP group, derived from the Italian and Continental concepts, lean more strongly to pointed toes, tapered toes and much greater popularity for slippers. The latter trend is due in great measure to the improved fitting qualities of the elasticized boxer tops and the "gorea,"—the new elastic front or side inserts.

Shoes designed for business and dress-up wear have all the cool ventilated features of their counterparts of a year ago, but they look less like "Summer shoes"—a facet of footwear fashions demanded by practical men who want to start wearing them early in the Spring and enjoy their cool comfort until after Indian summer.

Another outstanding feature of the new Spring shoes is the "skin" or surface stitching. Familiar in the low, close-to-the-sole "gum-tone" effects, this decorative stitching is now used to create wing-tip, moccasin and other effects.

Laced shoes for the warmer months use many three or four eyelet ties. These rise slightly higher in front than those of former seasons. High "tongues" are more in evidence on the slip-on styles and that, plus the increased use of the gores, add up to a more "covered-up" look.

CASUAL SHOES feature many more soft, supple deerskins whose glove-like texture is further enhanced by cushioned innersoles. The development of white leathers that can be washed in soap and water has led to revived style acceptance of black and white, brown and white, and all-white casuals. In an early try-out last year, they were snapped up by well-dressed men. There are more available now.

Here are some things to look for in the new batch of Spring shoes: more woven leathers in new effects including two-tones; more shades of black and brown toned with olive; the greater use of diamond and shield tip designs; new treatments of ventilated and nylon "plug" vamps; and the elimination of linings in dressy as well as sports shoes, as an aid to comfort via coolness.

It's All a Snap With New Shirts

You are liable to be seeing a lot of buttoned-down collar shirts without realizing what they are—buttoned-down. The trick is that there's a new shirt on the market that substitutes unseen snaps, under the collar points, for the usual buttons-and-buttonholes.

Lightweight shirting fabrics are liable to muss and crease in hot weather. But shirts with wash-wear finishes and synthetics have the tendency to maintain their neat appearance throughout an entire day—even the most humid ones—which would seem to make them "worth their salt" even if the wearer has them laundered in the conventional manner.

Gingham checks appear to be the most popular sport shirt patterns for this season, reports the American Institute of Men's and Boys' Wear. Patterns in slacks have declined somewhat. Solid colors selling best include grays, olives, blacks and browns.
