Classes in party food and home catering will start at the Oakland Branch of the YWCA, S. Crooks at Normandy road, Clawson, Tuesday.

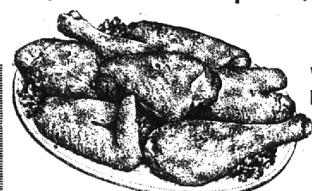
