The proposal is to be for the furnishing of the annual requirements of the City of Birmingham for approximately 1500 tons of 2 1/2" Crushed Stone and approximately 500 tons of 2 1/2" Road Gravel, F.O.B. 551 Eton Road, Birmingham.

The Crushed Stone and Road Gravel shall conform to Michigan State Highway Specifications, and the successful bidder may be required to furnish an inspection certificate from either the State or a recognized agency that the stone or gravel from which the material is taken has been inspected and found to conform to Michigan State Highway Specifications.

Material may be purchased any time during the period June 1, 1962, through June 1, 1963. All material shall be delivered to the DPW Yard at 551 Eton Road, Birmingham, Michigan.
