Cranbrook was founded by Mr. and Mrs. George C. Booth in 1904, and in 1947 they instituted the custom of setting aside a Sunday in May to entertain and honor the graduates of Cranbrook's four schools:

The Founders Day address will be delivered by the Rt. Rev. Ronald R. Williams, D.D., Bishop of Leicester, England.

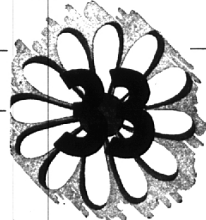
