WHAT TIME IS IT?

IT IS TIME TO:

Start spraying fruit trees once a week. Use a state approved combination material such as McLELLAN-BALL'S FRUIT TREE SPRAY (a wettable powder) or BONIDE'S TREE-TOX (a liquid). Read the instructions and follow them if you want a high percentage of worm-free fruit.

Look for birch leaf miners. If you see any, spray with ISOTOX. McLELLAN-BALL'S INSECT SPRAY or MALATHION. Spray twice more at 10-day intervals.

Control clover mites if they are bothering you. They are about 1/8" big. Inside the house use a vacuum cleaner. Outside provide an 18" strip of dirt between foundation and edge of lawn. Spray foundations and a 5-foot strip with ISOTOX and repeat at 5 to 7 day intervals until under control. They are worse on sunny side of house.

Thwart borers, most of them attack ornamental trees at the same time. He cut trees and shrubs are well fed, and spray trunks and main branches and soak the ground with DIELDRIN or DDT.

Kill weeds and noxious grasses:—

Dandelions—WEED-B-GON, McLELLAN-BALL.

WEED, DU PONT WEED, WEEDONE (DRY)

Clover—CLOVER KILLER, CLOVERCIDE

CHICKWEED—CHICKWEED & CLOVER KILLER

(Silvex)

Knotweed—CLOVERCIDE—(Endothal)

Clump Grasses—SPOT GRASS KILLER, AMINO-

TRIAZOLE

Crabgrass—AGRIC PRE-EMERGE

QUACKGRASS—(See Clump grasses).

Weed seeds in gardens—SESONE, AGRICO PRE-

EMERGE

Everything: (grass, weeds, flowers, trees)—Ham-

What will vines, roses, sweetpeas, etc., climb up?

WHITE REDWOOD OR ALUMINUM TRELLIS, strong TRAINETTES and brick walls and gutter pipes. On unpainted BRICK, STONE, or BLOCK WALLS WAYWARD VINE GUIDES will do the job.

Exactly what is the best and easiest method of feeding trees?

THE ROSS ROOT FEEDER is perfection in this area of feeding roots of plants, trees, & shrubs. The device holds the fertilizer, the hose holds the device, and you hold the hose. It puts the juice at any level you desire—from 1" to about 2 1/2 feet down. Various fertilizers are available for trees, roses, acid loving plants, and those that need iron. \$6.98.

These brown spots in the lawn—how do you fix them? Use a GARDIVATOR. (To stop the spots kill the dogs, or stop the snow mow.) To renovate the spots rake out some of the dead stuff, sprinkle seed, roll it in with the GARDEVATOR, cover with PEAT MOSS, and water every two days. \$5.95.

What is the easiest way to apply insecticides, weed killers, fungicides, and liquid fertilizers?

Use a HAYES SPRAY GUN, OR a HAYES TURF GUN. All you carry is the hose and a little bottle. The hose brings the water, siphons up the material from the bottle, mixes it & sprays it.

Are there any good supports for plants?

James Parris Named Deputy Administrator of Small Bus. Adm.

James L. Parris, of Birmingham, has been appointed as deputy administrator of the Small Business Administration in charge of Investment division activities, effective June 1, SBA Administrator John E. Horne announced today.

The new deputy administrator will be responsible for directing SBA activities under the small business investment act of 1958. This act authorized SBA to finance, help finance and supervise private small business investment companies which in turn provide equity capital and long-term financing to individual small business firms. The act also established an SBA lending program for State and local development companies.

Parris, of 245 Hupps Cross, is a senior attorney for the Ford Motor Co. and has been associated with that firm since 1957. From 1948 to 1957 he was an associate attorney with the New York City law firm of Simpson, Thacher and Bartlett; and served as a law clerk during the summers of 1946 and 1947 with the firm of Willie, Owen, Farr, Gallagher and Walton, New York City.

Police 'Zero In' On Lost Persons, Police Report Says

BLOOMFIELD TOWNSHIP—There were a lot of zeroes on the April police report for Bloomfield Township.

During the month there were no fatal accidents, no stolen cars, no armed robberies, no drownings and no suicides.

Statistics on missing persons were up, however, with police handling 14 cases. Chief Norman Delnisle attributed the disappearances to springtime's effect on youth in the area. He said all cases had been traced.

Police handled 321 miscellaneous complaints, drove 32,208 miles and issued 50 traffic tickets.

There were 40 accidents involving property damage and 14 personal-injury accidents during the 30-day period.

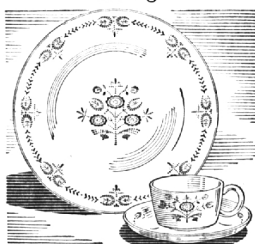

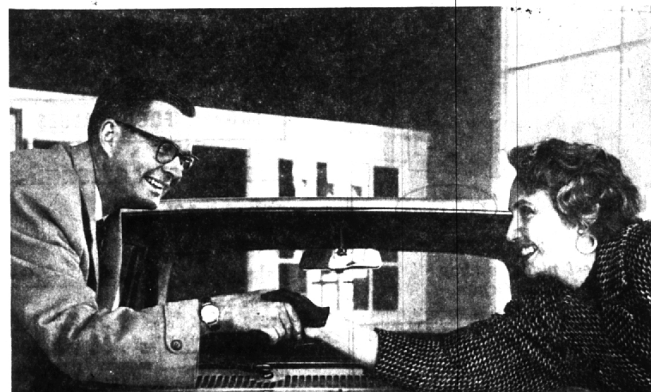
