Dr. Zimmerman To Preach Sunday

Dr. Paul A. Zimmerman, president of Concordia Junior College at Ann Arbor, will be the guest preacher at Lutheran Church of the Redeemer Sunday. He will speak at both the 9:30 and 11 a.m. services.

Dr. Zimmerman became president of Concordia Junior College on September 1, 1961. This is the 15th college of the Lutheran Church-Missouri Synod and is devoted to the training at the junior college level of pastors, teachers, and deacons.

BEFORE COMING to Ann Arbor Dr. Zimmerman was professor of science and religion at Bethany Lutheran College, Mankato, Minnesota. He also served as professor of science and religion at Concordia Teachers' College, Seward, Nebraska. In 1954 he became president of this school and served until coming to Michigan in 1961. He has held various offices in educational associations. In 1957 he served as president of the Nebraska Association of church colleges, and in 1961 was elected president of the Tri-State Conference, a conference of seven church colleges in Iowa, South Dakota, and Nebraska.

He was a Chaplain in the Pacific Theatre during World War II. In 1946 he became Dean of Students and Assistant Professor of Homiletics at McCormick and in 1949 was elected Vice-President. He came to Alma College as President in September, 1954.

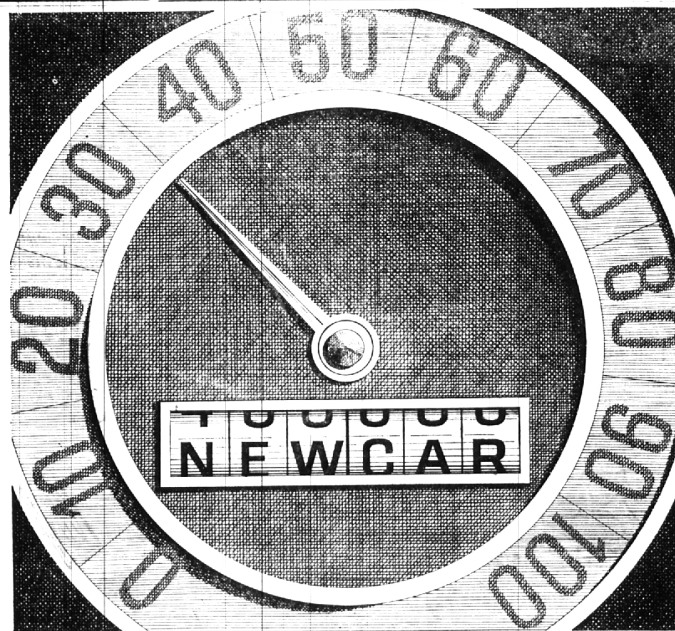
