separate towel rack should be hung at child-height beside the bathroom wash bowl. It is also a good idea to keep a step or block underneath the wash bowl so the child can stand at a comfortable height while washing.


Sherwin also suggests a full-length mirror in the child's bedroom. It can be conveniently mounted either on the wall or a closet door. To make it doubly useful and interesting to the children as well, try marking the frame in inches and feet to keep a record of the child's yearly growth.
