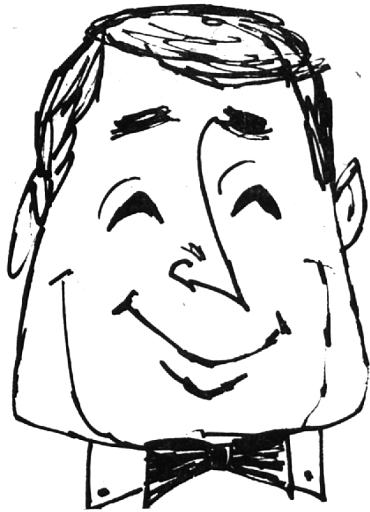
A Gathering of 'Friends'
