Scott said that Oakland Hills Subdivision already has such a petition on file and that several other areas have indicated interest in building laterals for connection with the proposed water transmission mains.

THE CHARGE to homes connected to Detroit water will be 30 cents per thousand gallons. Present township rates per gallon to homes now connected to community water systems is 20 cents per thousand gallons.

The 30-cent charge will just cover the cost to the township to pay Detroit a rate of \$1.82 per 1,000 cubic feet, plus maintenance and operational costs. In order to provide for retirement of the revenue bonds, an additional device charge of \$5 a quarter will be added to users' water bills. A meter charge of \$12 a year remains the same.

Existing water systems will tap into transmission mains at no extra charge. Additional homes joining the system at a later date will be charged a \$100 tap-in fee. A direct tap-in to the transmission mains will cost \$500.

CITY OF BIRMINGHAM, MICHIGAN NOTICE TO PROPERTY OWNERS WATER MAIN EXTENSION AND HYDRANT INSTALLATION IN G.E.W.R.R. RIGHT-OF-WAY.

The City Commission of the City of Birmingham will meet Monday, December 12, 1962, at 9:00 a.m. in the Conference Room in the Municipal Building to consider any objections to the construction of certain improvements in the Grand Trunk West, including Right-of-Way and to the creation of a special assessment district, and the cost of acquisition of an easement or license from the G.E.W.R.R. for the construction of a water main, approximately 500 ft. southerly from the water main, approximately 450 ft. westerly from River, along the east side of said industrial area, and installation of two fire hydrants on the water line.

The Commission proposes to create a special assessment district, the cost of this construction and said special assessment district shall consist of the following described property:

Lot 19 and Part of Lot 1 "Assessor's Plat No. 24" being a part of the Southeast ¼ of Section 31, T1N, R1E, City of Birmingham, Oakland County, Michigan, described as beginning at a point in the westerly line of said lot 1, distant 81' 59" 10" W 701.92 ft. and South 88° 11' 29" E 24 ft. to a point distant 81' 59" 10" W 173 ft. and South 88° 11' 29" E 24 ft. and South 31° 52' 20" E 401.28 ft. from the North ¼ corner of said Section 31 Thence North 33° 07' 40" E 152.79 ft. to the Easterly line of Lot 1.

Thence on a curve to the right along said Easterly line (Radius 2281.83 ft., long chord bears South 33° 15' 37" East 279.72 ft. a distance of 379.72 ft.

Thence South 1° 52' West 539.93 ft. to most Southerly corner of said Lot 19.

Thence North 31° 17' 20" West along the Easterly line of said Lot 19 a distance of 748.82 ft.

Thence North 75° 25' 40" East 266.68 ft.

Thence North 31° 52' 20" West 26.18 ft. to Point of Beginning—Containing .34 Acres.

Part of Lot 1, "Assessor's Plat No. 24" being a part of the Southeast ¼ of Section 31, T1N, Range 1 East, City of Birmingham, Oakland County, Michigan, described as beginning at a point in the westerly line of said lot 1, distant South 1° 59' 10" West 701.92 ft. and South 88° 11' 29" E 24 ft. to a point on the North ¼ corner of said Section 31 Thence South 88° 11' 29" East 162.63 ft.

Thence on a curve to the right along said Easterly line of said Lot 19 a distance of 2881.83 ft. Long Chord bears South 33° 15' 37" East 379.72 ft. a distance of 509.72 ft.

Thence South 54° 07' 40" East 152.79 ft.

Thence North 31° 52' 20" West 401.28 ft.

Thence North 88° 10' West 931.32 ft. to East Right-of-Way Line of 86 ft. wide River Road.

Thence North 1° 59' 10" East along SD East Right-of-Way Line 173.0 ft. to Point of Beginning—Containing 2.11 Acres—Part of Grand Trunk Western Railroad.

Plans and estimate of cost for this project are filed with the City Clerk of the City of Birmingham for examination by the public. Individual assessments by the public, if available, they will be computed by the Assessor after December 17, 1962. The necessity for this improvement is established by the Commission, and there will be another public hearing scheduled for the purpose of reviewing the assessment.
